

CONCERTS AT AVIVA STADIUM June 2024

We at MCD Productions are writing to inform you that we will be producing a series of concerts at AVIVA Stadium between 20th – 30th June 2024. Works will commence inside the stadium from Thursday 13th June and completed by Thursday 6th July. Normal working hours inside the stadium will be from 08:00hrs until 22:00hrs.

For the three Taylor Swift shows, early entry VIP packages have been sold. These Patrons and any other pitch patrons that arrive early will be directed to 2no. holding areas within the stadium footprint. These are the training pitch adjacent to the stadium Lansdowne Road and inside Gate 1 off Shelbourne Road. Early queuing will be discouraged by MCD, Security will be on patrol from the day before and Gardai from early morning on concert days.

Rehearsals / Sound checks will take place within the following times.

PINK: June 19th - 17.00 to 19.00: June 20th & 21st - Leaving Cert Lunchtime.

TAYLOR SWIFT: June 27th – 16.00 to 20.00: June 28th, 29th, 30th 12:00 to 15:00.

All truck / generator / air conditioning units are not permitted to run between 00:00hrs and 07:00hrs with the exception of final day of each artist where load out is permitted until 01:00am.

MCD has contracted the services of an independent Noise Monitoring Consultant to ensure that sound levels do not exceed the limits contained within the License. Noise levels will be monitored inside the venue as well as in local surrounding areas.

Please be assured that the overall Management Plans for the event, together with arrangements for public access and security have been developed in consultation with Dublin City Council, An Garda Síochána, the HSE, Dublin Fire Service, Irish Rail and Dublin Bus, and the Aviva Stadium.

MCD encourage all ticketholders to use public transport or private coach services. No concert parking will be permitted on residential streets. Residents with residential parking permits, who are affected by the restrictions, are permitted to park on surrounding streets using their permits.

A cleaning company will be employed to cover both inside and outside of the stadium pre and post-show.

Please note, Grand Canal Dart Station will be closed, from / to on concert evenings. No Darts will stop during these times. Full details on www.irishrail.ie

Local access only restrictions will be in place from 12:15hrs - PINK and 11:15hrs – TAYLOR SWIFT. (*subject to change*) These are not hard closures and local access after this time will be possible but will be monitored by Gardai.

An Garda Síochána will have road closures in place for through traffic on the following roads from 15:30hrs. (*subject to change*)

- Lansdowne Park.
- Lansdowne Lane.
- Lansdowne Road from Shelbourne Road to Herbert Bridge.
- Herbert Road.
- Newbridge Avenue.
- Bath Avenue.
- Londonbridge Road.

Subsequently the following roads will be closed to through traffic from 16:30hrs. (*subject to change*)

- The remainder of Lansdowne Road from Shelbourne Road to Pembroke Road.
- Shelbourne Road.
- Beatty's Avenue.
- Ballsbridge Avenue.

Temporary closures / diversions will occur post event depending on pedestrian numbers. These will be monitored and managed by An Garda Síochána and Security personnel and where possible will not affect local access. Residents carrying a form of ID / Proof of address may help ease access, but it is not compulsory.

While we will endeavour to ensure disruption is kept to a minimum, we will be available should you require additional assistance.
